Antitrust and Ethics Statement for Meeting Chairs

A. Antitrust Compliance Statement

It is the policy of ISEE to fully comply and encourage its members and nonmembers who participate in ISEE functions to fully comply with the antitrust laws of the United States. No employee or agent of the International Society of Explosives Engineers or any officer, director, or member acting on its behalf has the authority to engage in any conduct inconsistent with the antitrust laws or the Guidelines established by the ISEE Board of Directors, as posted on the ISEE website at www.isee.org/about/antitrust.htm/

B. Topics of discussion that must be avoided at Society meetings:

1. Prices, pricing, pricing procedures, increases or decreases in prices.
2. What constitutes a fair profit level.
3. Cash discounts or Credit terms.
4. Control of Sales or Allocation of markets and market shares.
5. Refusal to deal with a business, especially because of its pricing or distribution practices.

C. Fundamental Principles of the ISEE Code of Ethics:

ISEE members and nonmembers who participate in ISEE functions must comply with the Fundamental Principles and Canons of the ISEE Code of Ethics as posted on the ISEE website at www.isee.org/about/ethics.htm; that is, to uphold and advance the integrity, honor, and dignity of the engineering profession by using their knowledge and skill for the enhancement of humankind; serving their peers, their employers, and their clients with integrity, honesty, and fidelity; striving to increase the standard of excellence and prestige of the explosives industry; and supporting the profession and technical societies of their disciplines.
